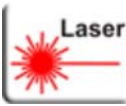

A brief introduction to the LS1280A: The Brilens laser DLP projector offers 240 Ansi lumens, a contrast of 100000:1 and a WXGA 1280 x 800 resolution. The lifespan of the laser is 30000 hours, which is over 20.5 years if enjoyed for four hours a day. As Brilens specifies the brightness of the projector in lumens, we have calculated an approximate ansi-lumen value in this case. An image width of up to 157 cm is possible, as the projector has 240 Ansi lumens. However, if room light is available, the image should be max. 105 cm wide. It was launched in 2016 and is no longer offered by the manufacturer Brilens, but is still a popular projector in our database.
