Manufacturer Kodak offers a DLP LED projector with VGA 640 x 360 resolution and a contrast of 1300:1 with the Ultra Mini. The manufacturer states an LED lifespan of 30,000 hours, which would be over 20.5 years with 4 hours of viewing per day. 100 Ansi-Lumen ensure that an image width of 87 cm is also possible. However, if room light is available, the image should be a maximum of 58 cm wide. The built-in 3800mAH battery eliminates the need for a power supply, allowing the projector to be set up quickly and flexibly. The model optionally recognizes Airplay and Miracast Screen Mirroring signals, making it possible to play videos with high resolution and surround sound directly from a smartphone, tablet or PC (Android, Windows and iOS) via WLAN. The model is also Full HD 1080P and 4K (compressed) compatible.



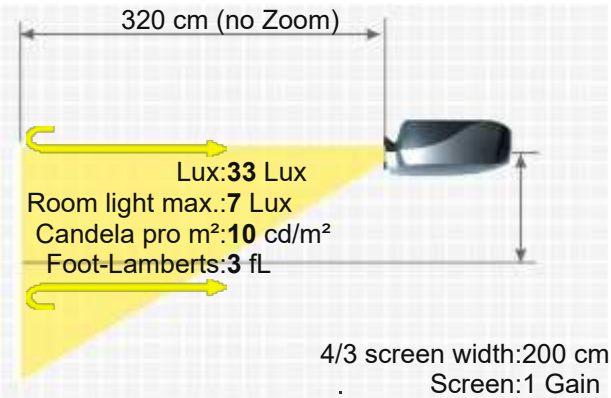

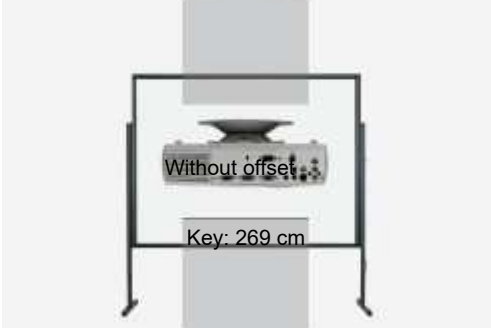
